Training, education and outreach programs are provided on an annual and as needed basis to emergency responders, governmental officials, businesses, parish elementary schools, and the community about risk management and emergency planning and response programs.

- Wally Wise Guy Shelter-In-Place Tour: Children in PK-2nd grade learn the importance of chemical safety.
- Emergency Preparedness Guide: Help fund a comprehensive guide for emergencies.
- Media Campaigns: Video, print media, and billboard campaigns to promote specific safety themes.
- HAZMAT: Support local governments HAZMAT response team through equipment and supply purchases.

(25%) Emergency Notification Systems

This activity is done on an annual basis. Establish and maintain emergency siren and warning systems in coordination with Ascension Parish to ensure that the general public is notified of tornadoes, hurricanes, flooding, chemical emergencies, or other serious situations, which might harm the general public. Testing, maintenance, operations reliability and associated costs for:

- Community Sirens
- Emergency Telephone Notification System
- Emergency Radio Station and Cable Overrides

ACAER believes the above listed activities lessen the burden of government and contribute to public safety. All above activities are in place and operational. ACAER is responsible for administration of these programs.
